Regional Analysis in Archaeology s99, s00, s02

Graduate core course. A survey of analytical methods used in archaeology to study prehistoric settlement systems. Specific projects include site and off-site sampling, population growth curves, site catchment, settlement hierarchy, central place, rank size, and nearest neighbor analysis.

Strategy of Archaeology w03

Introduction to problem formulation, theory, and method in archaeology, with emphasis on development of research designs. Focus on how archaeological research is conceived and planned, with consideration of differing viewpoints and their usefulness.

Study of Archaeology w00

An upper division survey of contemporary prehistoric archaeology. The emphasis is on the interplay between the discoveries that shape archaeology and the theories used to explain the archaeological record.

Warfare and Conflict w04

Examination of conflict and violent confrontation as these have been treated in anthropological literature. Cross-cultural comparison of institutions such as raids, feuds, ritual warfare. Consideration of application of anthropology to study of militaries, modern warfare, and large-scale ethnic conflict.

World Archaeology s98, w99, f02

An upper division survey of human culture history from its Stone Age beginnings to the primary civilizations of the Old and New Worlds. Emphasis on the interaction of technology, population and social organization in prehistoric societies around the world.

University of California, Los Angeles Extension

Archaeological Laboratory Methods: Lithic Analysis f98

Introduction to the analysis of stone tools in archaeological research. This course addresses both methodological and theoretical issues of lithic analysis. Students use various methods to analyze flake and stone tool collections.

European Pre-History: Neolithic to the Viking Age f03

Cultural history of the pre-historic peoples of Europe. Instruction concentrates on the period from the Early Neolithic, when agriculture was introduced, to the discovery of the New World at the end of the Viking Age. Students gain an understanding of the factors that produced the megalithic monuments of the Neolithic era, the rich burials of the Bronze Age, and the warlike societies of the Iron Age.

Human Origin and Culture s99 s04

A general four-field undergraduate course. Provides an overview of human physical and cultural origins. Covers the development and distribution of diverse populations, languages, social institutions, and beliefs. It provides an introduction to the methods of physical anthropology, archaeology, linguistics, and cultural anthropology.

Old World Archaeology f98, s01, s04

Upper division undergraduate survey of the culture history of the Old World from the Paleolithic to the rise of the Iron Age states. The course emphasizes the prehistory of Southwest Asia, the Mediterranean, and Northern Europe.

Prehistoric Archaeology f98, s99, f99 f00, f01 s02 f02 s05

An introductory course for anthropology majors that covers methods, archaeological problem solving and culture history. Specifically, the origin and development of prehistoric human cultures from hunting and gathering to the origin of state societies in both the New and Old Worlds.

Regional Analysis f98, s03

Undergraduate senior seminar. A survey of analytical methods used in archaeology to study prehistoric settlement systems. Specific issues include settlement distribution with respect to natural resources and settlement hierarchy.

Third World cultures f04, s05

Compares and contrasts non-western, kin-organized societies with class-oriented Western societies. Examines the historic relationship between Western societies and those of indigenous peoples in the Third World.
